## OSHA issues new lockout/tagout procedures

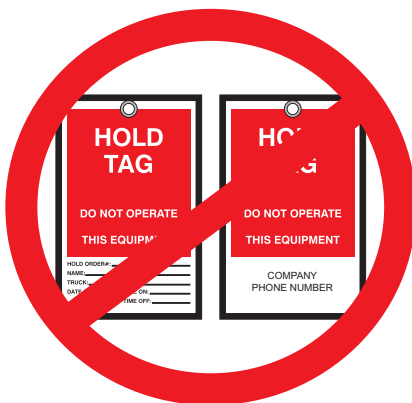
79 fed.reg. 20,315(2014) OSHA 1910.147

- ▲ Electric power generation, transmission, and distribution organizations are no longer exempt from OSHA 1910.
- ▲ Will affect areas of construction, repair, maintenance and line clearance tree-trimming.
